HOW TO FLESH OUT YOUR PICTURE BOOK STORYBOARD

Picture books are typically 16, 24, or (most commonly) 32 pages. When you create a storyboard, you may find yourself with blank pages to fill. Below you'll find ways our authors have added to their stories, not just to fill a page count, but to add value to their children's books. These can work for fiction and non-fiction topics. **HINT: If your book needs to start on a 2-page spread, the copyright information can be placed on the title page.**
